Your donation sends a message of encouragement and hope to our organisation, and inspires us to achieve even more.

Our work can only continue as a result of donations such as yours, and sadly the desperate need for our program remains.

We held seven programs in the second half of 2012, with youth suicide, drug and alcohol abuse being major issues.

I'm pleased to report that as a result of these programs, after attending their first camp, 71% of young people who had been suicidal were no longer suicidal, and 67% of those with drug and alcohol problems felt they had been helped to overcome them. After attending subsequent programs, we found that an incredible 100% who had been suicidal were no longer suicidal and 70% who had used drugs had successfully decreased or entirely stopped their usage of drugs.

We have 17 programs scheduled for 2013, and hope to turn many more young lives around.

I will be sure to keep you updated on our work during the year.

I thank you once again for your most generous and crucial support.
