



# Laura's Xmas (and other occasion) Pud-

Laura Riddell brought this end result to the International evening and I had requests to print the recipe in Koongga—thanks Laura

As you can see from this it is just a made up pudding that I thought would work and look good.... So no real recipe.....

Line a bowl with gladwrap making sure that you leave an overlap over the edges.

Cut a large Woollies chocolate sponge Swiss roll into about 1cm slices and use these to line the bowl. Fill in any holes with pieces of the Swiss roll to form a complete layer in the bowl and up the sides.

Make 3 different flavours of ice cream by using either a homemade vanilla base and frozen or fresh fruit and nuts. If you are in a rush a good brand from Woollies works fine too. (I used about 2I of ice cream in total )

I use chopped pistachio nuts in one as it creates texture and appears green. The second one I add frozen raspberries that have been chopped up to create a nice pink layer and finally I add pureed mango to the third layer.

Then spoon in each layer of ice cream following the line of the bowl so that it comes up the sides and leaves a bowl shape in the centre for the next layer. The final layer obviously fills it in completely. I freeze the pudding between layers to make it easier to keep the layer separate.

Then cover with glad wrap and freeze at least overnight.

To create the Xmas pudding look, turn out the pudding onto a plate and pour slightly cooled melted white chocolate over it so it looks like the custard on a traditional Xmas pudding.
